

Can a 1-fiber 4-wire transceiver be used as a switch



Overview

Short answer: Usually yes, you use them in pairs, but the “pair” can be a media converter on one end and a fiber switch (or SFP in a switch) on the other, as long as both sides speak the same speed, wavelength, and optical mode. Then, connect one end of the fiber cable to the transceiver and the other to the appropriate port on a switch, router, or another media converter.
