Overview

TL;DR: The US Department of Commerce is actively investigating Chinese technology corporation Huawei over concerns that equipment installed on US cell towers near military bases and missile silos could capture sensitive information and pass it along to China. Concerns over Chinese involvement in 5G wireless networks stem from allegations that cellular network equipment sourced from vendors from the People's Republic of China may contain backdoors enabling surveillance by the Chinese government (as part of its intelligence activity internationally) and. Over the past several years, Chinese companies like Huawei and ZTE have infiltrated our communications networks by selling their equipment to providers at artificially cheap prices. Over time, this has enabled Huawei and ZTE to significantly expand their equipment's presence in networks throughout. With Chinese telecom giants like Huawei and ZTE legally obligated to assist Beijing's intelligence operations, vulnerabilities in supply chains and the risk of foreign control over critical infrastructure remain pressing issues. Sources familiar with the matter told.
