

Distance between cable trays and fiber optic ducts

When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation. **WARNING:** Follow all OSHA regulations concerning confined space entry and work.
