

# Installation method of circuit box trip unit



## Overview

The installation procedure consists of inspecting, attaching required accessories, mounting the circuit breaker and connecting and torquing the line and load wire connectors. Mounting hardware and unmounted wire connectors (where required) are available as separate catalog. Clear any debris from area and check that all accessory wiring is properly routed for the trip unit being installed. If there is any damage or contamination, stop installation and contact the local sales office for factory authorized service. For MasterPact NW circuit breaker only: Manually depress. This bulletin includes information on the operation, trip unit replacements, and adjustable rating plug replacements for MicroLogic Electronic Trip Units. JD and LD Frame circuit breakers are for use in individual enclosures, panelboards, switchboards or other approved equipment. Note: Wires for optional features only. Remove the 3 retaining screws from the shunt plate inserts in the base of the circuit breaker frame.
