Is it safe to splice electrical wires without a junction box?

No, it is not safe to splice electrical wires without a junction box. Here are the key exceptions: Luminaires and Raceways: Splices for Chapter 3 installations (basic wiring methods) can sometimes be made within luminaires or in raceways, provided there's sufficient volume. Wire-splicing and pigtailling within a loadcenter cabinet (panel enclosure) is expressly permitted by NEC 312. 8 (A), and is quite safe (provided the splices are made up properly, of course): (A) Splices, Taps, and Feed-Through Conductors. The wiring space of enclosures for switches or overcurrent. Is it a code violation to unscrew the wire nuts and simply add an additional pigtail to the junction?
